ELIGIBLE WORK

Any original work in any medium completed in the 24 months before entry by any artist living, working or studying in Porirua. One artwork per artist. If the artwork is one of a multiple run, as in a photographic or other kind of print, then the number of prints must be specified (eg, 3/20).

All artworks must be available for sale. Work selected for this award must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition. Because of space limitations, some may not be accepted.

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is \$10 for students, \$20 all others and is expected at the time of application.

Note that your application is not accepted until you have paid your entry fee. No refunds will be given.

PRESENTATION

Entries must be presented in a manner that facilitates straightforward presentation with appropriate display or hanging devices. Multi-piece works must be ready to hang/display as one work or be attached together.

All artwork must be presented in protective wrappings suitable for storage at Pātaka before and after the exhibition.

All works with an electrical component must be accompanied by a current Safety Certificate from a Master Electrician. No wet artworks or works that may emit offensive odours will be accepted.

Any other concerns we may have as to safety, security, size or exhibition issues with a work will be discussed with the artist and if the work is withdrawn, the entry fee will be refunded.

ARTIST'S STATEMENT

This is optional and is limited to a maximum of 100 words. Please submit text preferably with your application, or in the body of an email sent to patakafriendsartawards@gmail.com by 12 July.

COPYRIGHT/ IMAGES/INSURANCE

While we will endeavour to protect copyright, work is submitted at the artist's own risk.

Pātaka does not insure items exhibited in the Bottle Creek Gallery. Exhibitors requiring insurance should make their own arrangements.

Any work received into the exhibition may be used for promotional purposes by the Friends of Pātaka.

IMPORTANT NOTES

The decisions the judges are final and no correspondence will be entered into.

A 35% commission will be charged for all sales of artworks.
